Charlotte is a very green city with over 200 parks .	SMALL TOWN Boone Boone is a small town in North Carolina with a population of around 19,000 people. Boone is located 5,000 feet above sea level in North Carolina's Blue Ridge Mountains . Boone was officially incorporated in 1872 . Boone is a popular destination for adventure seekers , including hiking, water sports, and skiing. Boone is a part of the Great Smoky Mountains region. Boone was named after Daniel Boone , a famous American explorer. Boone is the county seat of Watauga County . Watauga County Schools has around 4,700 students.	Wake County Wake County is the most populated county in North Carolina & home to 12 cities & towns . Raleigh is the largest city in Wake County & also the capital city of North Carolina. Wake County is home to both busy cities & quiet countryside . Wake County is home to over 1 million people and is the largest county in North Carolina. Wake County Public School System is the largest school district in North Carolina with over 150,000 students.	STATE TREE Pine The pine tree is the official state tree of North Carolina.
