★ STATE BIRD ★ Cardinal

Cardinals are the official state bird of Virginia.

The cardinal became the official state bird of Virginia in **1980**.

BOTH male & female cardinals sing which is a rare trait in songbirds.

Cardinals are one of the first birds to start singing in the **morning**.

Cardinals are often called **"REDBIRDS."**

The cardinal is the state bird in **7 states**.

Male cardinals are **bright red**, while females are **pale brown with reddish tinges**.

Cardinals commonly eat various **seeds, berries & small insects**.

Cardinals do not migrate long distances & can be found in Virginia year-round.



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Virginia Beach

Virginia Beach is the **LARGEST** city in Virginia with a population of over 455,000 people.

Virginia Beach is famous for its three state-long waterfronts along the Atlantic Ocean.

Virginia Beach was officially incorporated as a city in 1963.

Virginia Beach is home to the **Virginia Beach State Park**, a state park located in 1907.

Virginia Beach is known for its beautiful beaches and vibrant nightlife.

Chincoteague

Chincoteague is a small island town in Virginia with a population of around 3,200 people.

Chincoteague is famous for its **wild ponies** that live on nearby Assateague Island.

Thousands of people visit Chincoteague each year to see the famous **Pony Swim**.

Chincoteague is surrounded by beaches, marshes and waterways.

Chincoteague is a part of the **Chincoteague National Wildlife Refuge**.

Chincoteague is a barrier island between the **Atlantic Ocean** and **Assateague Island**.

Chincoteague has around 4,600 students.

Fairfax County

Fairfax County is the **most populated** county in Virginia with over 1 million people.

Fairfax County is home to three **incorporated towns**, plus many communities & urban centers.

The three incorporated towns in Fairfax County are **Vienna**, **Herndon** and **Chant**.

Fairfax County is part of the **Washington, D.C. metro area**.

Fairfax County has **600+ parks**.

Fairfax County Public Schools is the **largest school district** in Virginia with over 180,000 students.

Dogwood Blossom

The dogwood blossom is the **official state flower** of Virginia.

The dogwood blossom has been the official state flower of Virginia since 1966.

Dogwood trees are most common in the **eastern** part of the state.

Dogwood blossoms are **white or light pink** with four petals.

Dogwood blossoms are **pollinated** by bees, butterflies & other insects.

The "petals" of a dogwood blossom are actually **bracts** (leaves) called bracts.

The **leaf** of a dogwood tree is **yellow-green** in the center.

Dogwood trees are **native** to Virginia.

Dogwood blossoms are a symbol of **spring**.

Soybeans

Soybeans are one of Virginia's **most valuable** agricultural crops.

Most soybeans in Virginia are grown in the **eastern** part of the state.

Virginia grown soybeans are **planted** in the spring and harvested in the fall.

"Miracle Beans" are a type of soybean that are **smaller** and **grow faster** than regular soybeans.

Each soybean plant has **2-4** beans inside.

Soybeans are **used** in many products, including **soy sauce**, **tofu**, and **soy milk**.

One acre of soybeans can produce **over 50,000** bushels of soybeans.

Soybeans are **native** to Virginia.

Blue Ridge Mountains

The Blue Ridge Mountains stretch through western Virginia & several other states.

The Blue Ridge Mountains are famous for their **hiking** and **scenic views**.

Mount Rogers is the **highest** point in Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains at 5,729 feet above sea level.

Blue Ridge Parkway is a **scenic drive** through the Blue Ridge Mountains.

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Bluegrass Music

Bluegrass music is a style of folk music known for its fast rhythms & instrumental virtuosity.

Bluegrass music got its name from the **Blue Grass State**, Kentucky.

Bluegrass music is a **blend** of **folk** and **country** music.

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
